UnionPay QuickPass, UnionPay App, BoC Pay, Tai Fung Pay, CGB Pay, LusoPay, ICBC ePay, UePay, MACAU Pass Card, MPay, Alipay
Municipal Affairs Bureau's Public Services Centres and its sub-stations	Pay in cash, by cheque or cashier's order (payable to "Instituto para os Assuntos Municipais"), bank cards (UnionPay, VISA, MasterCard), WeChat Pay	
Designated banks (payment counter)	Pay in cash, by cheque or cashier's order (payable to "Fundo de Segurança Social") (the designated banks only accept cheques or cashier's orders of their own banks)

Contribution deadline: (contributions for long-term employees/arbitrary system contributions/employment fee for non-resident workers) contributions and employment fee for the preceding quarter are paid quarterly in January, April, July and October; (contributions for casual workers) contributions are paid in the month that immediately follows the employee's work month.

3. Municipal Affairs Bureau's Public Services Centres and its sub-stations, and designated banks only accept FSS' payments that are made on time.
4. Applies only to Bank of China Macau Branch, Industrial and Commercial Bank of China (Macau) Limited, Banco Comercial de Macau S.A., Tai Fung Bank Limited, Banco Nacional Ultramarino S.A. and OCBC Wing Hang Bank Limited.
