B) INTERNATIONAL MUSEUM DAY, WORLD TELECOMMUNICATIONS AND INFORMATION SOCIETY DAY: Communications Museum is going to participate in "The Museum Fair of Macao, Hong Kong and Guangdong Province 2010" with the theme of "Museums for Social Harmony" at the Tap Seac Square on May 9. Macao Post will issue a commemorative envelope for free distribution to the public and provide commemorative cancellation service for stamp collectors at the Temporary Postal Counter from 2:00 p.m. to 6:00 p.m.
